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Cyclone Contingency Plan Rajapalong Union Parishad, Cox's Bazar

1. Context:


Rajapalong Union Parishad is situated in Ukhia upazila of Cox's Bazar district, Bangladesh. The union is located in the heart of Ukhia upazila and the upazila market area. It is bounded by Ratnapalong union on the north, Palongkhali union on the west and south, and Dhumdhum union of Naikhongchhari upazila of Bandarban district on the east. It is about 32 kilometres away from the district town, and located in the middle-eastern part of Ukhia union. The union, rich in natural resources, is at risk of cyclones, heavy rainfalls, flash floods, coastal floods, landslides, groundwater drying, earthquake and Tsunami. Almost every year, people of this union have to survive by confronting with at least one cyclone and its associated heavy rainfalls, flash floods, coastal floods and landslides. Added to this is the presence of forcefully displaced Myanmar citizens, of which there was a massive influx in 2017. Due to the forced displacement of Myanmar citizen from Myanmar, the normal life-style of Rajapalong union has led to a major downfall.

In the context described, Union Disaster Management Committee deals with disaster by taking immediate decisions of distributing responsibilities. This is time consuming and not adequately helpful for disaster management activities. In the context of various survey reports and daily activities of disaster management committees, the Rajapalong Union Parishad has the opportunity to increase its capacity to tackle the above problems. A contingency plan can play a supportive role in this regard.

An initiative was taken in the light of the long-term plans of the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief of the Government of Bangladesh to improve the disaster management capacity of the local government institutions. There is a provision that the initiative could be made in accordance with the Disaster Management Act, 2012 and the Standing Orders on Disaster, 2010. With the financial support of European Union Humanitarian Aid and Civil Protection (ECHO), United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and ActionAid, Bangladesh have been implementing this activity.

2. Purpose of the Contingency Plan:

The main purpose of formulating the contingency plan is to help the Union Parishad and Disaster Management Committee of the Union Parishad in protecting people from potential loss of lives and resources by taking immediate/timely and accurate decision in the light of their own resources and capabilities in response to specific disasters.

3. Importance of the Contingency Plan:

Any plan can play a supportive role in completing a task easy and neat. Similarly, the contingency plan helps to do the right task at the right time and right way during helpless disaster. Therefore, it is an urgent need for an institution to have a contingency plan. As the primary local government institution, it is important for the Union Parishad to have a contingency plan to successfully protect the lives and resources of the people. This plan will, in particular, provide the following benefits-

- Respond to disaster comprehensively and timely according to the Standing Orders on Disaster (SOD);
- Ensure timely evacuation, rescue and primary treatment;
- Prepare a list of personal and private installations/facilities, and vehicles at the local levels for evacuation as well as ensure the arrangement/requisition of all installations and vehicles for use in times of emergency;
- Ensure the stockpile of adequate humanitarian relief materials/alternative planning and proper distribution;
- Identify risky areas and infrastructure;
- Assess the loss quickly;
- Help in the preparation of a timely rescue plan;
- Identify activities and resources;
- Determine the emergency duties and responsibilities of members of the Disaster Management Committee (UDMC) of the Union Parishad.

4. Legal Basis for Making Contingency Plan at the Union Level:

a. Disaster Management Act, 2012

According to sub-section (2) of section 20 of the Disaster Management Act, 2012, there is provision for making/preparing contingency plan at the upazila level. In accordance with the plan described in sub-section (1) of (2), the local disaster management committees shall formulate local disaster management plan considering their own locality and local disaster.

b. Standing Orders on Disasters, 2010

According to sub-section 3.5.4.1.3 of section 3.5.4 of the Standing Orders on Disasters (2010), there is a provision for making/preparing the contingency plan.

c. Local Government (Union Parishad) Act, 2009

There is provision in the Local Government (Union Parishad) Act, 2009 (article 7, article 45, and schedule 2 of article 47) for making/preparing similar contingency plan.

5. Union at a Glance/ Introduction to the Union (Profile):

Prior to the in-depth details of the contingency plan an overall picture of Rajapalong Union is provided. The total population of this union is 61,749. Most of the people here are agriculturists, labourers and businessmen. Besides, there are also a significant number of other professionals. Various government and private institutions are also found here. Among the institutions, the number of educational institutions is high. The union parishad is presented at a glance in the table below.

6. Risk Analysis:

Considering the risks, trends and dangers of the disaster, cyclone has been identified as the most high-risk hazardous event of this union. Heavy rainfall and landslide are considered as the second most risky hazardous events along with flash flood as the third most hazardous event. The above mentioned disasters are presented in the figure below.

7. Emergency Scenario of Cyclone/...Disaster:

Any contingency plan is formulated focusing on a particular disaster. Here, other related disasters are also considered. These are called the second most risky hazardous event and the third most risky hazardous event. Cyclone is considered as the most high-risk hazardous event in the case of Rajapalong Union. Heavy rainfall and coastal flood are considered as the second most risky hazardous events, along with flash flood and landslide as the third most risky hazardous events. The disaster scenario of this union is envisaged on the basis of all these disasters.

The cyclones that have hit the coast of Bangladesh and caused significant damages in Cox's Bazar district are presented in the figure below.

Considering the history of the cyclone of Cox's Bazar district and the population and geographical status of Rajapalong Union, two possible scenarios have been envisaged.

Scenario: 1

If a category 2 cyclone hits (example, Cyclone 'Mora'), the lower areas and roads of Ward Nos. 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 9 will be submerged in water.

Scenario: 2

Similarly, there is a possibility that most of the lower areas and roads of Ward No 1 (Pingirkul, Rejurkul); 2 (Alimora, Kasiarbill); 3 (South Harinmara); 4 (West and Middle Dikholia Palong); and 7 (Dailpara and Tipalong) will be submerged in water and will go under water due to flood. Hillslide is common in Dochori (ward no. 3), Tulatoli (ward no. 7), Baganpara (ward no. 8), and Lambasia (ward no. 9). Besides, there is a tendency of river bank erosion in Ward Nos. 2, 4, and 7.

10. Distribution of Duties:

According to the Standing Orders on Disaster, the Union Disaster Management Committee begins its activity by calling a meeting to address the potential disaster with the instruction to display cyclone danger signal number four (4). Therefore, it has been decided to consider signal number 4 as a signal to activate the contingency

plan. The figure below presents who should perform what duties and how during this time. Persons responsible for carrying out the duties shall consider the following scenario as per the Disaster Management Act, 2012, Standing Orders on Disaster, 2010 and Local Government (Union Parishad) Act, 2009.

11. Contingency Fund:

Under the "Strengthening Extreme Weather and Disaster Preparedness (S.E.W.D.P)" project, a contingency fund has been set up with a grant of BDT. 4,21,125 (approximately) to provide emergency response to the disaster in Rajapalong Union. This project is funded by ECHO, in collaboration with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and implemented by ActionAid, Bangladesh. The money has been deposited with the current account no. 3114-0311153255 in Bangladesh Agriculture Development Bank, Ukhia Branch. The above funds will be used in accordance with the approved union emergency fund guidelines.

ইউনিয়ন পরিষদের আপদকালীন তহবিল নির্দেশিকা

১) ভূমিকা ৪

ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ বাংলাদেশের সবচেয়ে প্রাচীন, ঋদ্ধ এবং ঐতিহ্যবাহী ছানীয় সরকার প্রতিষ্ঠান। এই প্রতিষ্ঠানটি নীর্ঘ সময় ধরে ধারাবাহিকতা রক্ষা করে জনগণের অত্যন্ত আপন হয়ে উঠেছে। প্রাতিষ্ঠানিক সক্ষমতার বিচারে ছল্প সম্পদে অনেক কাজ করতে পারার সামর্থের বিষয়টিও কালোত্তীর্ণ। ঐতিহ্যের ধারাবাহিকতা বজায় রেখে যাধীনতা পরবর্তী সময়ে জনআকাঞ্চার নিরিখে ইউনিয়ন পরিষদের দায়-দায়িত্ বেড়েছে। তবে সরাসরি সম্পদ ব্যবহাপনার ক্ষেত্র ঘটেছে বিপরীত ঘটনা। তাই অনেক কাঞ্চে এই ঐতিহ্যবাহী ছানীয় সরকার প্রতিষ্ঠানের দক্ষতা সম্পূর্ণভাবে কাজে লাগানো সন্ধব হত্তে না; যেমনং ছানীয় পর্যায়ে নুর্যোগ ব্যবহাপনা।

দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা বিষয়ে ইউনিয়ন পরিষদের দক্ষতা যেমন অধিক তেমনি দায়-দায়িত্বও অনেক। তবে তথবিল স্বল্পতার জন্য এই প্রতিষ্ঠানটি তার সক্ষমতার পূর্ণ সন্থাবহার করতে পারছে না। নিত্য লব্ধ অভিজ্ঞতা, বিভিন্ন গবেষণা প্রতিবেদন এবং দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা বিষয়ে বিশেষজ্ঞ ব্যক্তি ও প্রতিষ্ঠান এই মতামত প্রদান করেছেন।

এই প্রেক্ষাপটে ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ পর্যায়ে একটি আপদকালীন তহবিল গঠন সময়ের দাবী। বিদ্যমান আইনে এই ধরণের তহবিল গঠনের সুযোগ রয়েছে।

২) আপদকালীন তহবিল গঠনে আইনী ভিত্তি ঃ

ছানীয় সরকার (ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ) আইন ২০০৯ এর নবম অধ্যাহে পরিষদের আর্থিক ব্যবস্থাপনা, সম্পদ ও তহবিল সংরক্ষণ বা বিনিয়োগ এবং বিশেষ তহবিল গঠন বিষয়ে বলা হয়েছে।

"৫৫। (১) পরিষদের তহবিলে জমাকৃত অর্থ কোন সরকারি ট্রেজারিতে বা সরকারি ট্রেজারির কার্য পরিচাশনাকারী কোন ব্যাংকে বা সরকার কর্তৃক সময়ে সময়ে নির্ধারিত অন্য কোন আর্থিক প্রতিষ্ঠানে জমা রাখিতে ইইবে।...

- (৩) পরিষদ, সরকারের পূর্বানুমোদনক্রমে, কোন বিশেষ উদ্দেশ্যে পৃথক তহকিল গঠন এবং সংরক্ষণ করিতে পারিবে, যাহা সরকার কর্তৃক নির্বারিত পদ্ধতিতে পরিচালিত ও নিয়ন্তিত হইবে।"
 - ৩) (ক) আপদকালীন তহবিল গঠনের লক্ষ্য ও উদ্দেশ্য ৪

আগদকালীন তহবিল গঠনের মূল লক্ষ্য "আপদ ব্যবস্থাপনায় ইউনিয়ন পরিষদের প্রাতিষ্ঠানিক সক্ষমতা বৃদ্ধি"। এর ফলে নিম্রোক্ত উদ্দেশ্য পুরণ হবেঃ

- ইউনিয়ন নূর্যোগ ব্যবহাপনা কমিটির আপদকালীন জর্মনী সাড়াদান সক্ষমতা বৃদ্ধি করা সম্ভব হবে; এর আন্ততায় আপদকালীন পরিকল্পনা প্রণয়ন এবং বাস্তবায়ন অন্তর্ভুক্ত হবে;
- আপদ মোকাবিলার স্থানীয়, জাতীয় এবং আন্তর্জাতিক সহায়তা গ্রহণ ও ব্যবস্থাপনা সহজতর হবে।
 (খ) আপদকালীন তহবিল থেকে যে সকল কাজ করা যাবে ঃ

১।ইউনিমন পরিষদের আপদকালীন তহবিল পরিচালনা নিদেশিক।

ভাহাসীর কবিত্ব চৌধুরী চেয়ারাম্যান বালাগাগ ইউমিত্বন পরিবদ ভাষয়া, কক্সবাভার।

- আপদ মোকাবিলায় সময়য়ত ইউনিয়ন দুর্যোগ ব্যবদ্বাপনা কমিটির সভা করা এবং বিপদাপন্ন জনগোষ্ঠির ক্ষয়ক্ষতি ব্রাসে প্রয়োজনীয় তথ্য দুর্যোগ সংগঠিত হওয়ার পূর্বে পৌছানো;
- প্রয়োজনে বিপদাপর জনগোষ্ঠি এবং তাদের অছাবর সম্পদ ছানান্তরে ছানীয় উদ্যোগের সাথে সামশুস্য রেখে
 ছানান্তর প্রক্রিয়া দ্রুত ও নিরাপদ করনের ব্যবছা করা;
- আপদকালীন সময়ে আশ্রয়কেন্দ্র ব্যবস্থাপনা অধিকতর মানবিক ও বিপদাপন্ন জনগোষ্ঠির প্রয়োজনানুগ করা;
- দুর্যোগ পরবর্তী জরুরী সাড়াদান এবং অন্যান্য রাণ কর্মক্রম পরিচালনা ক্রত এবং স্থানীয় প্রয়োজন অনুযায়ী করা।
- ইউনিয়ন আপদকালীন পরিকল্পনায় চিহ্নিত এবং বাস্তবায়নের জন্য গৃহীত কাজ।

8) আপদকালীন তহবিল গঠন ও ব্যবছাপনা ঃ

- ছানীয় সরকার (ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ) আইন ২০০৯ এর আওতায় প্রচলিত বিধি-বিধান মেনে এই তহবিল গঠিত হবেঃ
- আপদকালীন তহবিল পরিচালনার জন্য রাষ্ট্রায়ত্ব তফশীলি ব্যাংকে একটি আলাদা ব্যাংক হিসাব খোলা হবে। যা পরিচালনার জন্য ইউনিয়ন পরিষদের মূল তহবিলের ব্যাংক হিসাবের বাক্ষরকারীগণ এই হিসাবেরও ছাক্ষরকারী হবেন: তবে ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ চেয়ারম্যান এবং সচিবের যৌথ খাক্ষর ব্যাতিত কোন লেনদেন করা যাবে না:

- বাংলাদেশের প্রচলিত নিয়মে এই তহবিলের হিসাব ব্যবহাপনা এবং নিয়মিত নিয়ীঞ্চা/ অভিট সম্পন্ন করা

- তহবিল পরিচালনার ক্ষেত্রে কোন ধরনের আইনী বিষয়ের উদ্ভব হলে ছানীয় সরকার (ইউনিয়ন পরিষদ)
 আইন ২০০৯ আলোকে এর সমাধান করা হবে।
