Detailed Discussion on Changing Voice (Imperative Sentence)

If the sentence starts with main verb (present form), the structure will be—

Structure: Let+Subject+be+past participle form.

Example:

Active : Do the work.

Passive: Let the work be done.

Changing Voice (Imperative Sentence)

If the sentence starts with 'Do Not' ,the structure will be—

Structure:Let not+Subject+be+past participle form.

Example:

Active :Do not hate the poor.

Passive:Let not the poor be hated.

Changing Voice (Imperative Sentence)

If the sentence starts with “Let+Personal Object(me,us,you,them,him,her)” ,the structure will be—

Structure:Let +Subject+be+past participle form+by+personal object.

Example:

Active :Let me do the work.

Passive:Let the work be done by me.
